Anaphylaxis, Airway and Advanced Life Support Emergency Response Workshops Perth Children's Hospital SIM Centre

This half-day will enable registrants to complete two emergency response workshops each of 90 minutes duration. Registrants will all complete an anaphylaxis workshop, and either an airway or an advanced life support workshop. These workshops will take place at the Perth Children's Hospital Simulation Centre. Facilitated by leaders in the management of anaphylaxis, airway crises and ALS, there will be 40 places in total. Registration is open to ANZAAG symposium registrants. Associated ASCIA/ANZAAG drug hypersensitivity session Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre

This session links into the ASCIA conference which will be running from September 3-7, 2019. There is an extra cost to attend this symposium which brings together experts in the broader field of drug hypersensitivity and will be of interest and relevance to all immunologists, anaesthetists and associated providers who work in perioperative allergy.

Clinical Patient Audit Session

This year anaesthetists can participate in a clinical patient audit session that will earn them 20 CPD practice evaluation points.

The topic of the audit will be about self-reported allergies by patients in the perioperative period. Each participant will be required to collect and submit simple data from 20 consecutive patients in June or July. The pooled data will give a snapshot of the prevalence and relevance of reported allergies perioperatively and will be discussed at this session.
